Qualification purpose

The OAL Level 5 Diploma in Logistics Management aims to develop skills, knowledge and understanding of management in a logistics environment. It also aims to broaden core commercial, technical and managerial skills, knowledge and understanding in logistics.

Qualification coverage

The OAL Level 5 Diploma in Logistics Management covers:

- Management in a logistics environment as a mandatory unit
- One of the two optional units:
 - Supply chain management in a logistics environment
 - Transport operations management in a logistics environment
- And two of the following four units:
 - Warehouse management in a logistics environment
 - Inventory management in a logistics environment
 - Managing the movement of goods in a logistics environment
 - Managing the movement of people in a logistics environment

On achievement of this qualification, learners will have covered the skills, knowledge and understanding of management in a logistics environment, including the management of people, resources and plans in a logistics environment, and within chosen specialist areas.

Qualification Objective

Qualification objective: supporting a role in the workplace.

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is designed for learners who are working or wish to work in the logistics sector at management level, and who wish to further their knowledge, skills and understanding in this area and in relevant chosen specialist areas.

Entry requirements

Learners must have:

- A level 3 qualification or above in logistics or a related discipline, such as management
Or
- Work experience at an appropriate management level in a logistics or related environment

For learners whose English is not their primary language, it is the centre's responsibility to ensure that learners have a suitable level of English in order to meet the requirements of this qualification and it is the centre's responsibility to record this.

Centres must ensure that learners have the potential and opportunity to achieve the qualification successfully.

This qualification is not approved for use by learners under the age of 18 years and OAL cannot accept any registrations for learners below this age group.

This qualification will support progression of learners to:

- Increased responsibility or promotion at work
- Level 6 or above qualifications

Assessment methods

This qualification is internally assessed and marked by the centre and externally quality assured by OAL and assessed using the following assessment method:

- Portfolio of evidence

The portfolio of evidence may consist of various types of assessment evidence including work-based projects, observation of learner performance, question and answer, written records, assignments, projects etc. The portfolio is internally set and marked and externally quality assured by OAL. A portfolio mapping document is available for approved centres to download from the OAL portal.

Learners are required to achieve all learning outcomes and assessment criteria within the relevant four units of assessment and all assessment criteria must be assessed and achieved.

Knowledge outcomes must be assessed using methods that meet the needs of learners, this may include responses to oral or written questioning or the use of assignments or tests.

All assessments are subject to internal quality assurance within approved centres providing this qualification. External quality assurance of assessment within approved centres is provided by OAL.

This qualification is not graded, successful learners will achieve a pass.

Qualification achievement

To achieve this qualification learners must achieve a total of four units of assessment: The mandatory unit, one unit from group A and two units from group B.

All units are allocated a credit value which provides an indication of the size of the units in terms of total qualification time (TQT), 1 credit = 10 TQT.

All units have been assigned total qualification time (TQT) and guided learning hours (GLH):

- GLH is the average estimated time that a learner will spend under the direct supervision of the tutor /trainer and includes invigilated and practical assessments
- TQT is the average time a learner will spend carrying out unsupervised leaning activities such as assignments, course work etc. **PLUS** the GLH

The units set out what learners need to know and understand or be able to do and these are described in learning outcomes in units of assessment. The learning outcomes are defined by assessment criteria and these criteria must be assessed successfully for a learner to achieve each unit.

Achievement of the required four units will mean the qualification has been completed and will be subject to approval of a claim for certification. OAL will issue a certificate complete with the learner's name, the qualification title, the credits achieved, and the grade awarded.

Centres must ensure they understand all qualification requirements prior to the registration of learners and to carrying out assessment. Assessment of learners must not take place before the registration of the learner with OAL.

Centres must retain copies of learner assessment records for at least three years after certification. Registration and certification fees may be subject to change and centres should be fully aware of registration and certification end dates to ensure learners are not disadvantaged.
